**Professor Paul Hodges, PhD**  
MedDr DSc BPhy(Hons) FACP;  
NHMRC Senior Principal Research

Paul has three doctorates; one in Physiotherapy and two in Neuroscience. His large multidisciplinary research centre bridges from basic science to clinical practice with an emphasis on conservative management of musculoskeletal pain, incontinence and breathing disorders. He has published >400 scientific papers and book chapters and is one of the most highly cited physiotherapy researchers in the world. He has won the ISSLS Prize for back pain research on three occasions and in 2013 he was made an Honoured Member of the Australian Physiotherapy Association, their highest honour.



**Mr Daniel Moon, Urologist,**  
Director of Robotics, Epworth  
Healthcare, Melbourne

Dr Daniel Moon is the Director of Robotic Surgery at Epworth Healthcare and an Honorary Clinical Senior Lecturer at The University of Melbourne and Monash University.

He has performed over 1000 major laparoscopic +/-robotic procedures, published the first Australian series of laparoscopic radical prostatectomy in 2008, performed the first Australian robotic cysto-prostatectomy in 2009, published the largest Australian pyeloplasty series in 2011, and established a robotic partial nephrectomy program at Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre, publishing the first Australian series of this procedure in 2014. Dr Moon has also developed a high volume urological prosthetics practice, restoring continence and potency in men following prostate cancer treatment. He has published the largest Australian series of both artificial urinary sphincter insertion in 2014, and suburethral male slings in 2017.



**Mr Greg Malone, Urologist,**

Dr Malone has over fifteen years' experience in Urological practice. His areas of special interest are Advanced Robotic Surgery (Prostate, Bladder & Renal Surgery), Penile Implant Surgery, Male Urinary

Incontinence & Voiding Dysfunction and Vasectomy & Vasectomy Reversal. He is one of the founding surgeons involved in the establishment of Queensland's first Robotic Surgery Unit at the Greenslopes Private Hospital (Qld Robotic Surgery (QRS)) and was a member of the surgical team involved in the first Robotic Radical Prostatectomy undertaken in Queensland in 2008. He performed the first Robotic Partial Nephrectomy in Qld in 2010 and has since applied this surgical approach to over 1000 urological cases. Dr Malone was appointed as a Mentor to American Medical Systems in 2009 and was admitted to The Court of Examiners with the Royal Australian College of Surgeons in 2015. He is a past-Chairman of the Australian and New Zealand Association of Urological Surgeons (ANZAUS) and has recently completed his term as the Meeting Chair and Convener of the USANZ 2014 Annual Scientific Meeting.
